April We started this month in Brighton, England with Holiday Bible Club! We themed the club on the life of Elijah! The children had a great time. There was a record number of Children that came. We also had conversation about salvation with some of the children.

We also helped our friends in Liverpool on a youth retreat they held in Wales. We had such a sweet time with the young people!

I truly believe a mini revival took place the last night as the pastor gave the Word! A few young men trusted Christ as their Saviour and many many other one-on-one conversations conserving salvation and how to stand as a Christian young person.

May We took our place back in Oxford and settled back into our home at the Ranch (we were gone for 6 weeks the previous month in Brighton). We've been preparing for the kings coronation outreach with t-shirts, John and Romans, and gospel leaflets. There was over 30,000 gospel leaflets and John and Romans passed out. Many other Christian groups were in London handing gospel literature as well. Dillon and his evangelism partner were able to give the Arch Bishop of Canterbury a gospel leaflet as

well! He was the man who crowned King Charles. What an opportunity!

We also took a missions trip to Canada with the young people from a few of the churches we work with here in England as well as young people from the Netherlands. We were involved in evangelism, the Niagara Bible Conference, serving in the Local church, street evangelism, etc. There is a man that is returning in September to see if the Lord is leading him back there to serve the Lord full time.

June As we continue to highlight and summarize our months we prepared and planned for four families in our church to go to Zimbabwe for 5 weeks including the pastors family. They went to begin a mission. As the Lord opens doors there, ultimately we are praying toward the planting of a church in Victoria Falls, Zimbabw. Much can be said about this opportunity but we will save that for the next letter! We changed rolls in the church and stepped up to fill all these voids as people were away! The Lord helped us tremendously and we were able to visit many people, help strengthen believers, and continue the ministries. One blessing was we were able to live in our own home for 5 weeks (we stayed at one of the families homes during their absence). One answer to prayer was to have a new family join our children's club. They claim to be Muslim. We're thankful for the opportunity to share Christ Jesus as God with them!

Dillon went to the Epsom horse races and the Appleby fair. These are mainly gatherings of Travelers. At the Epsom horse races we passed out gospel leafletting and participated in open air preaching! The Appleby horse fair was a week of

camping and gospel meetings each evening. Dillon had the opportunity to speak to a couple boys who were seeking Christ. He was able to point them to the Lord! Others were spoken to about their souls as well.

July We've continued to hold the fort at Oxford Baptist Chape until everyone returned at the end of the month! As everyone returned we went right into camp work weeks. Many people gathered to help set up Camp for these two weeks! We had prayer meetings in the evening which were sweet times. All who helped, stayed on the property. It was great being around so many like minded people.

How do we know that God is real? And is the Bible true?" These children are so precious. Yet we are seeing a real lack of biblical knowledge amongst children in the UK. I fear this same lethargy is creeping to America. Stay the course and, *"Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it."*
