July through September were very eventful months of ministry, travel, and time with family. We are so thankful for the opportunity that we had to travel back to Canada and the US for a two-month furlough. Arezoo lived in Vancouver, British Columbia for many years, and we had not been back for a visit since before we moved to Romania – six and a half years ago! We were able to spend time with Arezoo's family and visit Greater Vancouver Baptist Church and several other supporting churches in Vancouver and northern Washington.

In July, we had a major project that was much needed at our Bible college. Since its construction, only the front side of the building had been insulated properly, while the back side of the building had never been insulated. During the winter months it was always very cold, and we had numerous issues with mold and dampness. We are very thankful that we were able to get the rest of the building covered, plastered, and painted.

In August, our church organized a men and boys campout. We went to the village of Rogojel, about four hours north of Timișoara. It is located on the side of the second tallest mountain in central Transylvania – Vlădeasa. The property is owned by Gospel Light Baptist Church of Cluj-Napoca (Biserica Baptistă Lumina Evangheliei). There was a lot of work to do to prepare. I took a group of men and some teens up there to help get the cabins ready for the camp.
