Greeting to our friends, supporters, prayer warriors, and everyone that has a part in the continued work of Blind Faith Ministries!

Christmas is right around the corner and it's another season for Beth's Blessings. This special project that was started by my wife and daughter a few years ago is an effort to bless widows, the underprivileged, and national pastors' families with Christmas gifts - we often buy goats, chickens, and other supplies that will help them get through the year. Between now and the first quarter of next year, we are looking to eliminate the \$50,000 remaining balance on a building project in northern Uganda that we have been working on over the past few years. By eliminating this payment, we would be able to do work on some existing church buildings that are in desperate need of repair or rehab and to purchase more land where these churches are located. Your prayers as well as your support for this need would be greatly appreciated.

We are thankful for the work that is getting done by Pastor George and Pastor Taban in northern Uganda and South Sudan. As Pastor George develops curriculum in Uganda, we are prayerful that this can be a long-term solution of discipling and training men for the future. Pray for Pastor Taban and our churches on the border of South Sudan that have been unable to meet due to the conflict that is going on in that region. We are rejoicing that one church has been able to reopen and is now meeting again. Uganda and South Sudan have historically been friendly nations, so we are praying that this border dispute will get hashed out quickly. We are friends with people on both sides of that border, so we ask for your prayers that this conflict will cause no division because of the national honor held by the Ugandans and South Sudanese and that it would not prevent the moving forward of the Gospel in that region of the world.

It has been exciting to hear that the work in Venezuela continues to grow under Pastor Carlos' ministry through his Bible Institute and the church planting efforts of their graduates. He is doing a great job there!

We love you all very much and are grateful to get a partner with our friends, family, and supporting churches to get the gospel around the world and the Great Commission fulfilled. Thank you!
